that at their regular meeting on Thursday, September 10, 2015, the Cupertino Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER). The CDBG CAPER describes the goals and accomplishments for eligible CDBG capital housing projects and public service grant funds for program year 2014 (FY 2014-15). The Cupertino Housing Commission meets at 9:00 a.m. at City of Cupertino City Hall (Conference Room C), 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014. Interested parties are invited to attend and be heard. If you wish to challenge the Cupertino Housing Commission's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall, 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014 at, or prior to the public hearing. The CDBG CAPER describes eligible activities implemented within the program year 2014 (Fiscal Year 2014-15) for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds and their relationship to the priority housing, homeless and community development needs of the City of Cupertino. Federal regulations and the City's CDBG Citizen's Participation Plan require the CDBG CAPER be made available in public locations for community review for fifteen days. The plan will be available at City Hall starting August 31, 2015. Comments are due to the Community Development Department no later than 5:00 p.m. September 15, 2015. Persons needing special assistance to attend the meeting under the Americans with Disabilities Act should call at least 48 hours prior to the public meetings to ensure their needs can be appropriately accommodated.
