ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE: THE CITY OF CUPERTINO, a Municipal Corporation of the State of California ("City") hereby gives notice that it will accept Bids for construction of the following public work:

**CITY PROJECT NUMBER 74,366.08A
TRAFFIC SIGNAL MODIFICATION AT S. DE ANZA BOULEVARD AND RODRIGUES
AVENUE**

1. **BID SUBMISSION:** The City uses a two-part Bid process with Bids in **Envelope "A"** and Statements of Qualification and Financial information in **Envelope "B"**. City will accept **Envelope "A" and Envelope "B"** before **2:00 p.m. on May 24, 2016 in the City Clerks Office**. Bids will be publicly read at **2:10 p.m. in City Hall, Conference Room C, located at 10300 Torre Avenue (see attached Bid Submittal Map)**. City's representative will call out the designated time in the Office of the City Clerk, 10300 Torre Avenue, stating that the period for accepting Bids is closed. The Bid opening will be in accordance with procedures set forth in Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders).

3. **STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS:** Each Bidder shall be required to submit a "Statement of Qualifications" in accordance with Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) and Document 00450 (Statement of Qualifications for Construction Work).
4. **DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK:** Work generally consists of modifying existing traffic signal at S. De Anza Blvd and Rodrigues Avenue per the plans and specifications. This intersection is maintained by the City of Cupertino. Modifications consist of removing existing traffic signal standards and roadway lighting electroliers, relocating existing traffic signal equipment and roadway signs, furnishing and installing all hardware for proposed signal modification; such as traffic signal standards, poles, pull boxes, foundations, signal and pedestrian indications, wiring, conduits, mast arm-mounted signs, etc., to provide a fully operational modified signal and related striping, signing, wheelchair ramps, sidewalk, AC pavement, curb & gutter, and traffic control.
5. **CONTRACT TIME:** Work shall be completed within 60 Calendar Days from the date when Contract Time commences to run. A notice to proceed is anticipated to be issued on or before June 20, 2016.
6. **Expected Expenditure:** The City's expected expenditure is **\$95,000.00** (This price is expected – not guaranteed)
7. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE:** A **California Class "A" General Contractor or "C-10" Electrical Contractor**, contractor's license is required to Bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Removal, handling, and/or disposal of hazardous materials may, by law, require hazardous substance removal certification by the Contractor's State License Board.

8. **REQUIRED CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR REGISTRATION [Labor Code Section 1771.1]:**
 - A. Owner shall accept Bids only from Bidders that (along with all Subcontractors listed in Document 00430 Subcontractor List) are currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.
 - B. Subject to Labor Code Sections 1771.1(c) and (d), any Bid not complying with paragraph 1.01A above shall be returned and not considered; provided that if Bidder is a joint venture (Business & Professions Code Section 7029.1) or if federal funds are involved in the Contract (Labor Code Section 1771.1(a)), Owner may accept a non-complying Bid provided that Bidder and all listed Subcontractors are registered at the time of Contract award.
9. **PREVAILING WAGE LAWS:** The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents.
10. **INSTRUCTIONS:** Bidders shall refer to Document 00200 (Instructions to Bidders) for required documents and items to be submitted in sealed envelopes to City Clerk's office, as well as applicable times for submission.
11. **SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES:** City will permit successful Bidder to substitute securities for retention monies withheld to ensure performance of Contract, as set forth in Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention), in accordance with California Public Contract Code, Section 22300. By this reference, Document 00680 (Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention) is incorporated in full in this Document 00100.
12. **PRE-BID CONFERENCE:** No Pre-bid conference will be held for this project.
13. **PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS:**

To obtain a copy of the bid documents, Bidders must download a set of bid documents from the City of Cupertino Web site at: <http://www.cupertino.org/index.aspx?page=119>, or from a plan room or trade journal site that carries them. The City will post all addendums to the project on the City web site and it is the Contractor's sole responsibility to download the addendums for the project. If a Contractor wishes to be on the plan holders list for the project the Contractor must send an e-mail to: winniep@cupertino.org containing the following information: Contractor's name, address, phone and fax number, and e-mail address for future communications. The plan holders list will be updated daily. Bidder is responsible for printing all of the bidding documents.
14. **BID PREPARATION COST:** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of plan and specification printing and preparing their Bids.
15. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:** City specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, or re-bid, or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or quality of the Work.
16. **PORTION OF WORK PERFORMED BY THE CONTRACTOR:** The Contractor shall perform no less than 51% of the Work, excluding Specialty Items, with its own organization. Specialty Items will be identified on the Bid Form.
