







- Factors to Consider
  - Palo Alto has only 1 school district, Cupertino has 2
  - PAUSD concerns schools only in Palo Alto
  - Palo Alto Safe Routes to School active since 1985
  - Palo Alto Safe Routes to School has a designated Safe Routes to School Champion PTA person at each school
    - Accountability
    - Parent- Driven Efforts
    - Grassroots approach
  - PAUSD incorporates mandates bicycle/pedestrian education during school time in Kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup> grade
