

# GAS SAFETY AFTER EARTHQUAKES

Turn **OFF** the gas **ONLY** when:

1. You **smell** natural gas, or
2. You **hear** a hissing sound, or
3. You **see** the gas meter dial spinning

*Leave the gas on unless you notice any of the above.*


If you turn off the gas, PG&E must turn it back on for you...Never turn gas back on yourself!

Check your gas valve periodically by turning it 1/8 turn in either direction and then turning it back 1/8 turn to the vertical ON position. A 1/8 turn will not turn your gas off.

## How to Turn Gas OFF

Turn the valve 1/4 turn, in either direction, so the valve is crosswise or horizontal on the pipe.
