
If we do not receive a response, we will plant a tree selected for you.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q When will the tree be planted?

A Planting will begin approximately one month after receiving this flyer.

Q Where will the tree be planted?

A Trees will be planted in the public right of way either between the street and the sidewalk or behind the sidewalk.

Q What are my responsibilities?

A Owners or their renters will need to water the tree once a week during the summer months for the first 2 years. If you need assistance with this, please contact the City. The City will be responsible for all other maintenance. Please go to www.cupertino.org/access to request maintenance.

Q What are the benefits of trees?

A Environmentally, trees assist with cleaning of water and air, help reduce heat, improve habitat and sustainability. Trees increase aesthetics, provide social and health benefits, reduce energy costs, increase property values and provide a connection to nature.

Q How can I get involved?

A Discuss your tree selection with neighbors and work together to create a theme. You can also register your tree and receive important updates when you scan this QR code or the QR code located on the tree identification badge.
