Block Party Basics



Barricades (delivered & picked up)

- FREE!
- Application & petition 30 days before event
- Petition with 2/3 support
- 9 a.m. to dusk
- 20' clearance path
- City-provided insurance

- Ambulance
- Emergency Readiness Demo
- Green / Energy-savings Sweep
