Starting around 2,000 years ago Coast Miwok indigenous people first occupied the island. In 1775, Spanish Lieutenant Juan Manuel de Ayala and crew discovered the island and called it "Isla de Los Angeles" (Angel Island). In 1863, Angel Island was used in the Civil War as a base in which they could protect San Francisco Bay. Then, it was used as a quarantine and immigration station in the early to mid-1900's. Many referred to Angel Island as Ellis Island of the West.
