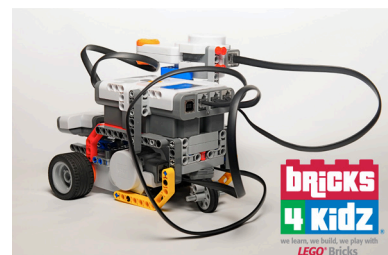

Map of School Sites



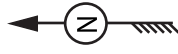
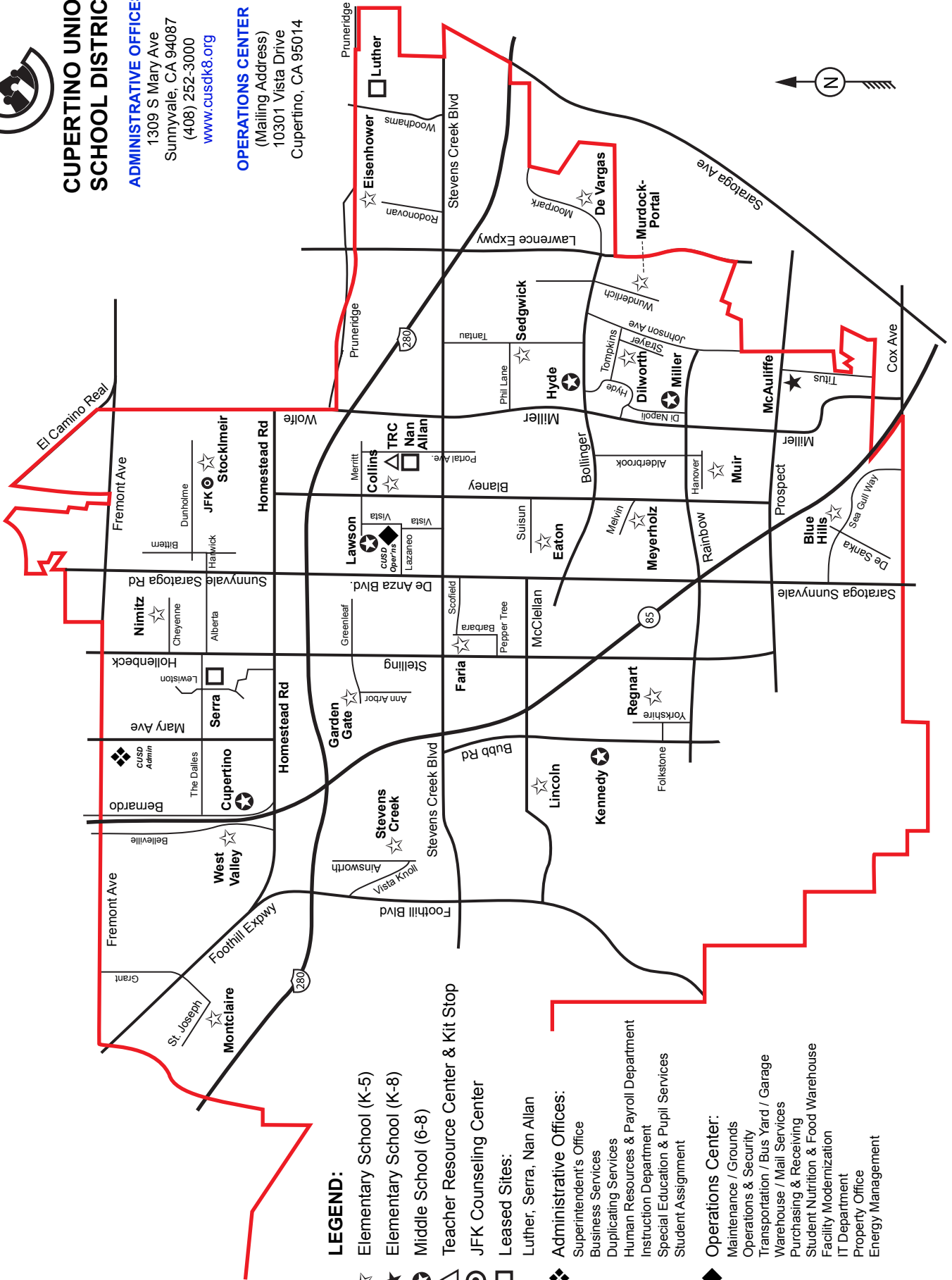
