The Guide Dog training facility is a perfect place to learn how these service animals are trained and raised to help people with disabilities. We will also tour the Marin County Civic Center designed by famed architect Frank Lloyd Wright.



Founded in 1942, Guide Dogs for the Blind is the largest school in the country where they train dogs to be companions for those who are visually impaired. We will have our own private, docent-led tour through the facility where the dogs learn their specialized skills.


They provide the training and dogs free of charge to all accepted clients. Since their inception, *Guide Dogs for the Blind* has trained 14,000 dogs and counting. If we are lucky enough, we may be able to see the dogs in action.

We Also Have a Docent-Led Tour of the Marin County Civic Center

The center was built in 1960 by the famed architect, Frank Lloyd Wright. Wright was known for his extremely unique and appealing style of "Organic" architecture. He believed in designing buildings that were in harmony with nature, humanity, and its environment.

Some unique features of the building include entrances controlled by vertical grills of gold anodized metal and interior spaces featuring glass walls to allow light to penetrate from the exterior of the atrium. The Marin Civic Center project was Wright's largest public project.
