
WHAT'S NEW IN SAN FRANCISCO

The area around Market Street and Van Ness Avenue has become the center of the newest construction boom in San Francisco, with as many as 2,000 units of housing planned to open over the next few years. Farther down Van Ness, the new California Pacific Medical Center begins to stretch towards the sky, and will eventually encompass nearly one million square feet of hospital and medical office space!

Gary will also lead us through Mission Bay. The marshy inlet was filled in long ago-with abandoned Gold Rush-era ships, rubble from earthquakes and fires, and anything else that might turn water into developable land. It is now the prospective site for a new home for the Golden State Warriors, as well as home to the newly opened UCSF Medical Center.



In the midst of our other adventures, we will stop for a delectable Italian lunch at Pompei's Grotto, an establishment that has withstood the test of time, serving fresh and delicious food to locals and visitors alike for 70 years.
