This is the 50th anniversary of the Summer of Love, a social phenomenon that became a transformative moment in California history. Tens of thousands of disaffected young people converged in San Francisco's Haight-Ashbury district in the summer of 1967 and captured the attention of the world.



Join us to view "On the Road to the Summer of Love" at the California Historical Society. The exhibition explores the cultural context--from the Beat poets to the experimental art scene--that made San Francisco a magnet for hippies

as well as the center of a social revolution that rippled across the country.
