Effective January 1, 2017 the Cupertino minimum wage will be raised to \$12.00 per hour.

The Cupertino Minimum Wage Will Increase From \$10.00 to \$12.00 Per Hour Effective January 1, 2017

On Tuesday, October 4, 2016 the Cupertino City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2151, establishing a citywide minimum wage as part of a regional effort to increase the minimum wage to \$15 by 2019. The minimum wage rate will be adjusted annually on January 1. Covered employees include anyone who performs two hours or more of work per week in Cupertino. Covered employees are entitled to these rights regardless of immigration status. 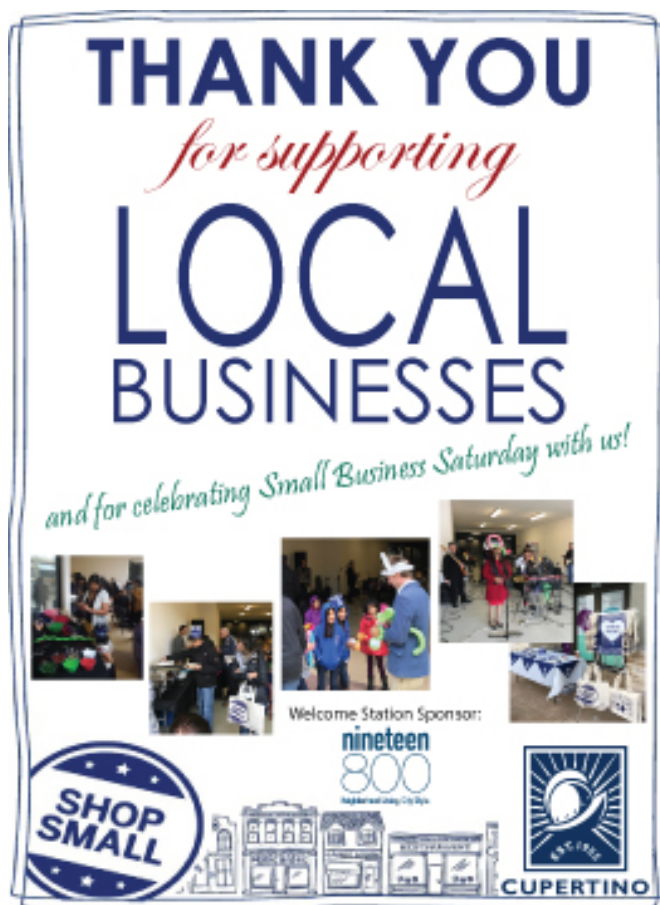
