

ADDENDUM NO. 1

Regnart Road Slope Stabilization Project PROJECT NO. 2017-23

Bid Opening: June 27, 2017 - 2:00 P.M. Issue Date: June 21, 2017

The following questions were received at the pre-bid conference held on June 14, 2017. The City's responses/clarifications follow each question.

1. What are the longitudinal limits of the work?

The limits of the improvements are shown on plan sheet C-4

2. Who is responsible for California Fish & Wildlife permits?

The City of Cupertino has an environmental firm that will assist the City in acquiring permits and providing any required monitoring.

Responsibility of the Contractor is limited to coordination and accommodating monitoring personnel, if any.

3. What is the number of working days?

The work must be completed and accepted by the City by October 1, 2017.

4. Is a silt fence required?

A silt fence is shown to be installed on Sheet C-10 of the project plans

5. Can the road be completely closed?

The contractor will need to submit a traffic control plan for review and acceptance by the City. The City recognizes that some construction equipment may require a full shutdown to perform the work.

Because there are no alternative routes, temporary full closures will be allowed, but must be conducted in a manner that will allow passage of motor vehicles, either after an agreed on time period, or based on demand and wait times.

Emergency vehicles must be allowed passage as expediously as possible.

6. What is the edge treatment?

Following the construction of the roadway, an AC berm is to be installed. See sheets C-4, C-5, C-7, and C-9

7. Is the contractor responsible to remove fallen debris that would interfere with the work?

Only as necessary to perform the work.
