Travel with us to San Francisco for a docent-led tour in Pacific Heights, known for its colorful Victorian row houses, famous mansions and beautiful gardens.

Visit the inside of a period Queen Anne Victorian. See where "Mrs. Doubtfire" and "Princess Diaries" were filmed, and where Bill Cosby and Francis Ford Coppola lived. We will also tour the Queen Anne

Hotel, a historic Victorian mansion, originally a girls' boarding school that narrowly survived the 1906 San Francisco earthquake. Our leisurely walk will be approximately 2 hours with no hills to climb.

Enjoy a hosted lunch at the Stinking Rose, known for their delectable garlic dishes. Ding! Ding! In the afternoon we will stop at the San Francisco Cable Car Museum for time at your leisure to learn more about this icon of San Francisco.

The museum houses a collection of cars along with historical and explanatory exhibits on the cable car system, the world's last manually operated cable car system. On display are various mechanical devices and a large collection of historical photographs. The museum houses the powerhouse and depot for the San Francisco Cable Cars, as well as three antique cable cars from the 1870's including the only surviving car from the first cable car company, the Clay Street Hill Railroad No. 8 grip car.
