## Amendments to the City of Cupertino General Plan 2000-2020

DATE OF ADOPTION BY COUNCIL	DESCRIPTION
July 21, 2009	Addition of office allocation of 483,053 square feet; Addition of new office allocation to the category of "Major Companies."
April 6, 2010	Incorporation of language reflecting the adopted 2007-2014 Housing Element; Incorporation of language reflecting the adopted Heart of the City Specific Plan Update.
June 1, 2010	Amendment to the Historic Preservation Policy, addition of new properties, and reclassification of Historic Properties.
October 15, 2013	Amendment to the various figures and tables in the Land Use/Community Design, Circulation, Environmental Resources/Sustainability and Health & Safety elements to reflect the approval of the Apple Campus 2 development, change in land use designation of a park, vacation of a segment of Pruneridge Avenue, and the change in setback ratio for Tantau Avenue.



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
