

PRESCHOOL LUNCH BUNCH

Q: What are the benefits?

A: Reinforcement of preschool content such as additional playing time, crafts, storytelling and more. Your child will make stronger connections with friends and teachers, strengthen their English skills, and will learn to express their feelings and needs even more! Lunch Bunch will also help prepare your child for the future by getting them accustomed to longer days without nap time. Most importantly, Lunch Bunch is FUN!

Q: Is lunch provided?

A: No, we don't provide lunch due to dietary restrictions and possible allergies. We ask that you pack a lunch for your child. Drop off their lunch in the morning when dropping off for preschool. The teachers may refrigerate and warm up your child's lunch if needed.

Q: May I only sign up for 1 day of Lunch Bunch during the week?

A: Yes! You may choose to go to lunch bunch on Tuesdays or Thursdays (Tiny Tots); Mondays or Wednesdays (Super Tots); or you may sign up for both days depending on your schedule.

Q: Do you have Lunch Bunch on Field Trip Days?

A: No, Lunch Bunch is not scheduled on Field Trip days because the change of location may be hard on a child and the field trip location may not have space for us past preschool hours. For Tiny Tots there won't be field trips scheduled during the winter session due to the unpredictable weather but we will make sure to bring extra special guests to class and will have Lunch Bunch on all preschool days.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: The cost of Lunch Bunch depends on the number of meetings per session. We charge per session (Fall, Winter, and Spring). The fee breakdown per day is \$12/day for residents and \$14.50/day for non-residents.

Q: What are the Lunch Bunch hours?

A: Lunch Bunch is from 12pm—2pm after preschool is over. You don't need pick up from preschool and take to lunch bunch. Lunch bunch students remain after preschool is over. The teachers will be with your child until 2pm instead of 12pm.

Q: How do I register?

A: You may register online at www.reg4rec.org or in person at the Quinlan Community Center office.

Q: Is this program eligible for prorating?

A: Yes, if you register after the start of the program we may prorate Lunch Bunch for days missed but you have to register in person at the Quinlan Community Center office.

Q: Is Lunch Bunch program refundable?

A: No, there are prior arrangements that need to be made, so we cannot issue refunds after registration. You are welcome to try out the class by purchasing a Lunch Bunch Pass (see information below).

LUNCH BUNCH PASSES

Q: May I buy one pass and use it to try out the class? How much does it cost?

A: Yes! You may purchase a pass and use it on the day you prefer: Tuesdays or Thursdays for Tiny Tots. Mondays or Wednesdays for Super Tots. The cost of 1-day pass for Lunch Bunch is \$14 for residents and \$17 for non-residents. The pass is a little more expensive than the class but it allows you to try out the class without committing for the full session.

Q: May I use one pass to try out both days of the week?

A: No, each pass may only be used one time and must be given to the teachers at the beginning of class on the day you plan on using it.

Q: Do I have to use the pass immediately after purchasing?

A: No, you are welcome to use it at any time during the preschool year (Fall, Winter, or Spring). The passes expire at the end of the preschool year. Don't forget to give the teachers your pass on the day you plan on using it.

Q: May I buy more than one pass?

A: Yes. You are welcome to buy more than one pass so you may have it in case of an emergency; however, the passes are non-refundable or transferable.

Q: What happens if I don't use my pass?

A: The Lunch Bunch Pass is non-refundable. If you don't use it during the current preschool year, the pass will expire. The pass is non-transferable, you are not able to give the pass to another family.
