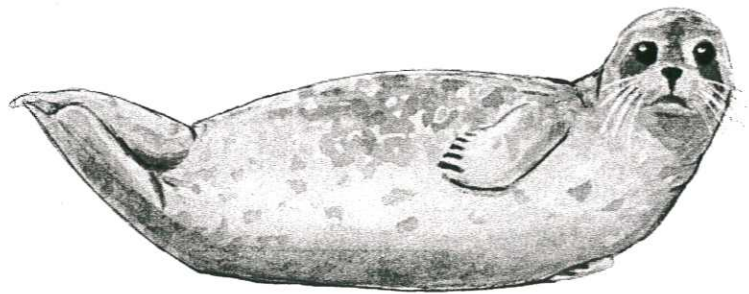




Share Discovery Through Travel

The Marine Mammal Center in Sausalito was created in 1975 to provide rehabilitation and care for injured and ill marine mammals. While their main focus is elephant and harbor seals, they are just a part of the over 20,000 marine mammals of all types that the Marine Mammal Center rescues and treats every year. The center also provides education on ocean stewardship, teaching nearly 30,000 students and adults yearly about marine mammals and caring for the earth's marine environments.

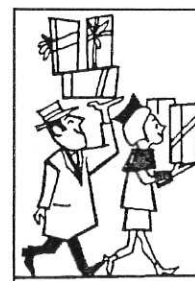
