Join us for the world's most popular opera, *La Bohème*, the passionate, timeless, and incredible story of love among young artists in Paris.

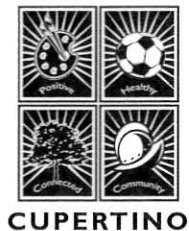

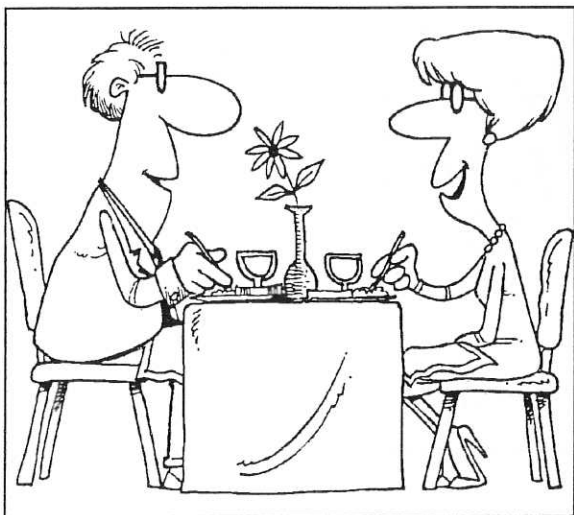
