This 24 hour course is designed to teach a variety of skills including: professionalism, leadership, lifeguard duties, situational awareness, assists, basic rescues, and the fundamentals of CPR/First Aid. This interactive program will combine classroom learning, skill practice in the pool, and hands-on practical experience working with the Blackberry Farm Lifeguard Team. To participate you must be able to swim 50 yards continuously, float on your back, tread water, and swim underwater. A course completion certificate will be awarded on the last day of class.
