We Learn A Bit Of History About Marin County

Marin County was named after Chief Marin, an 18th century leader of a branch of the Coast Miwok. The Museum of the American Indian is one of the little known treasures of Marin County. Situated on an actual site of a Miwok Village, the Museum is devoted to Native

American culture and is the only one of its kind in the Bay Area.

We will have a docent-led tour of a village site where the Coast Miwok lived for hundreds of years, and explore its galleries displaying the beautiful craftsmanship of the Coast Miwok Indians.

Enjoy a hosted lunch at Finnegan's Marin, an American bar and grill meets Irish pub. Awarded best bar/restaurant in Marin. Finnegan's will be just the spot to pause and enjoy a delicious, three-course lunch.
