#### **Application Process**

<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Any student who is currently in 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade can apply. Preference will be given to Cupertino residents, but we will try to accommodate all interested students if possible.

The following must be submitted:

- □ Completed application
- □ Answers to all supplemental questions
- □ Signed Conditions and Agreement Form
- Completed registration form with payment (Fee: \$150 residents; \$180 non-residents)
- Copy of school ID or proof of age

<u>DUE DATE</u>: Applications must be submitted **by May 5<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm**. Decisions will be made the week of May 14<sup>th</sup> and applicants will hear back by May 18<sup>th</sup> on final decisions.
