Bi-Rite Creamery makes all of their ice cream by hand in small batches. Their creative flavors draw lines that sometimes wrap around the block with tempting combinations like Balsamic Strawberry, Roasted Banana, and Honey Lavender.

At **Salt & Straw** you will love exploring fun, interesting new flavors. Their classic San Francisco flavors include Roasted Strawberry Coconut, Sightglass Coffee and Single Origin Dandelion Chocolate, and Berkeley Olive Oil, just to name a few.

When you walk into **Smitten** scoop shop, there's the ice cream at the counter. After you pick your flavor, the *Brrristras®* pour fresh ice cream base into a *Brrr®*. A chilly fog then blows over the counter as liquid nitrogen freezes each scoop to-order.
