Friday, November 9, 11am-6:15pm

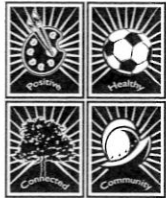

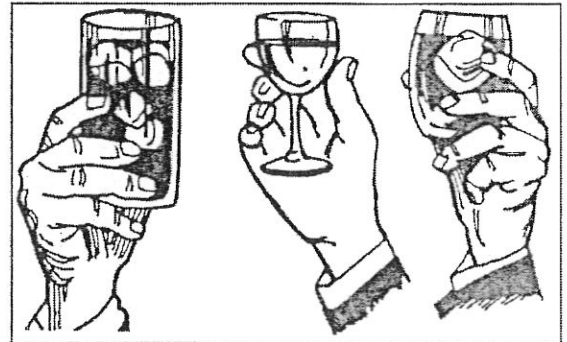
