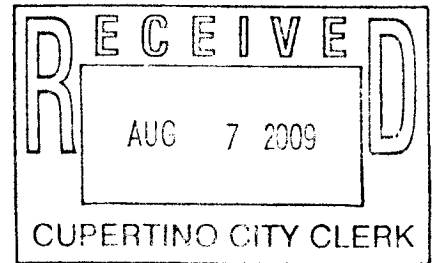


Statement of Mark Santoro
