Dear Techie Teen Volunteer Applicant,

Greetings from Cupertino's Parks and Recreation Department! We are thrilled you want to volunteer with the Cupertino Senior Center. This packet is intended to provide you with detailed information about the application process and program expectations. Please carefully read all application information and be sure to make note of important dates and requirements.

Please note: Due to the standards of this program, there is an application process with supplemental questions and a required interview process. Interviews are tentatively scheduled to occur **Thursday, August 29 from 4:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.**

Program Overview

The primary goal of Cupertino's Techie Teens volunteer program at the Senior Center is to help teens give back to the community by engaging the 50+ community to assist in developing their technological skills. Our volunteers can expect to gain the following experiences: leadership roles, public speaking opportunities, interpersonal communication, and much more. While anyone between the ages of 14-18 may apply, we would like to remind all applicants that space is limited and acceptance into the program will be based on answers to supplemental questions, availability, and interview performance. Any teen with a strong desire to work with our 50+ population is encouraged to apply. Successful applicants will be enthusiastic, dedicated, and devoted to providing our 50+ population with an enriching experience.

What is the Cupertino Senior Center?

The Cupertino Senior Center strives to provide a welcoming and friendly center for anyone 50 years or older, by enhancing a healthy lifestyle through quality education, recreation, services, travel, socials, and volunteer opportunities.

Volunteer In-Service Training

In-service Training will be held on **Tuesday, September 10 from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.** During training, our teen volunteers will become versed in translating device and application language, conversing with 50+ adults, building interpersonal skills with 50+ adults, and how to assist with technological questions.

Requirements & Expectations

Techie Teen Volunteers that are selected to the program will be expected to meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least 14 years old by the first day of training
- Attend all training meetings
- Be fingerprinted and cleared
- Volunteer for a minimum of 2.5-3 hours every other week for the full duration of the program (September 17, 2019 - May 9, 2020)
- Must create and present a 30 minute workshop at the end of the session in May
- Must provide own transportation to and from program sites
- Arrive on time for shifts and stay for the whole duration of scheduled shift

Program Payment:

If selected, payment of \$20 is required to cover the cost of fingerprinting, program shirt, nametag, and other program training materials. Checks should be made out to *City of Cupertino*. Payment will be due on training day, **Tuesday, September 10**.

Selection of Techie Teen Team:

Due to the popularity and standards of the program, we will be using the answers of the supplemental questions as well as an interview to select our volunteer team. In addition, we will review an applicant's availability to determine acceptance into the program. Applicants will also be required to come to an interview on **Thursday, August 29 from 4:30pm - 8:00pm**. Once selected, volunteers will be sent acceptance emails with next steps and details on training. Program assignments will be distributed in September.

Application Submission:

Applications must be submitted by **Friday, August 23 by 5:00pm**. Applications may be submitted to the Cupertino Senior Center located at 21251 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino CA, 95014. Applications may also be emailed to Recreation Coordinator Amanda Hui, at AmandaH@Cupertino.org. Late applications will not be accepted.

City of Cupertino Parks and Recreation Department Techie Teen Volunteer Program FAQs

Q: I'm not available for the in-service training. Can I still take part in the program?

A: Tech Teen Volunteers must be available for the full in-service training program and their assigned volunteer shifts that occur every other week. For safety and training reasons, exceptions will not be made.

Q: I am unsure of my school schedule at this time. Will I be able to apply later?

A: There are limited spots, and all spots will be filled within the week of the deadline. If any spots remain, they will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

Q: When will I know if I am selected for the program?

A: The week of September 2nd.

Q: I have a filled schedule and anticipate an increase in extracurricular activities throughout the year. Should I still participate in the program?

A: Techie Teen Volunteers must be available for their assigned volunteer shifts which will occur at least once every other week. Shifts will begin Tuesday, September 17th and will end Saturday, May 9th. There will be a break from Tuesday, December 17th to Saturday, January 4th. Techie Teen Volunteers must also be available to present their 30 minute workshop at the end of the program in May.

Q: Are there shifts scheduled during school breaks?

A: Yes, shifts will be scheduled during ski and spring break based on the need of the center.

Q: I do not have any teaching experience, should I still apply?

A: Yes, we encourage anyone interested to apply.

Q: I am interested, but may not have transportation to get to the center. What should I do?

A: Please still apply. There is public transportation (VTA) and a Via Cupertino Shuttle, the City's pilot shuttle program, which will be starting fall 2019.

Q: Will I receive documentation for my service hours?

A: If you require documentation of hours, please talk to City staff any time before the end of your volunteer period and they will complete the appropriate documents.

Q: Is there a uniform requirement?

A: Yes, all volunteers will be provided a shirt and a nametag which they must wear during their volunteer shift.
