<u>DISCUSSION</u>	<u>ACTION</u>
<p>1. Council Meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. City staff will be providing an improvement plan update of the 65% design and seeking council direction on the considered alternatives at the City Council meeting of September 17, 2019.b. City requested Valley Water representative to be present at the September 17, 2019, City Council meeting. <p>2. Alternatives Under Consideration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Alternatives under consideration are;<ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Multi-use path which has paved surface with removable railing throughout.ii. Footpath without asphalt treatment on the top and with minimal removable fences.iii. Footpath with Alternative 4 on-street bikeway improvements.iv. The City is working on the considered alternatives.b. The City will be presenting the pros and cons of considered alternatives, along with an estimated cost at the September 17, 2019, City Council meeting.c. All the options considered will be for the entire 0.8-mile stretch.d. The City is considering not to impact the Wilson Park ballfields.e. The City is considering relocating the Valley Water maintenance ramp to the north side of the creek which will eliminate the need for one bridge and makes the other bridge location flexible.f. Relocating the ramp will not require tree removal and will likely require fewer	

<p>bridge removals during VW maintenance work because any work VW will be doing upstream in that location would not require bridge removal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> g. Valley water would be able to access the maintenance ramp via the westside parking lot of Wilson Park. h. City is working on the details and estimated cost of maintenance ramp relocation to the north side of the creek. City to share the details with Valley Water once finalized. i. Valley water will let City know if they can construct the ramp using their own forces, with City reimbursement, depending upon their workload and other factors; after reviewing the final design plans of the proposed maintenance ramp. j. City and VW staff to further discuss details regarding the drainage treatments for the footpath option. <p>3. Items Under Consideration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The City to prepare a list of items that are under discussions with Valley Water and attach it to the staff report. The list of items will be shared with Valley Water before the September 17, 2019, City Council meeting to provide their input. <p>4. Lazano Lane and De Palma Lane treatments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The City is working on the fencing treatments for Lazano Lane and De Palma Lanes. The City is considering a higher fence with screens, removable planters, shrubs, etc. along Lazano Lane and De Palma lane homes; Valley Water indicated that measures should be installed at the property line. <p>5. Valley Water Letter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. City requested a letter from Valley Water showing their support and cooperation for our Regnart Creek Trail coordination efforts. Valley water agreed to provide the letter before the September 17th Council meeting. <p>6. Next Meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Monthly meetings scheduled for the 4th Tuesday of every month from 1:30 to 2:30 p.m. 	
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
