



CITY COUNCIL MEETING NOTICE CARMEN ROAD PEDESTRIAN-BICYCLE BRIDGE FEASIBILITY STUDY

The City of Cupertino Public Works Department invites you to attend the City Council meeting for the Carmen Road Pedestrian-Bicycle Bridge Feasibility Study. Since November 2018, the City staff has been studying the feasibility of a grade-separated bridge structure to provide a connection for pedestrians and bicyclists between neighborhoods north and south of Stevens Creek Boulevard at Carmen Road.

The adoption of a resolution to approve the Carmen Road Pedestrian Bicycle Bridge Feasibility Study will be discussed and voted on at the City Council meeting held on Tuesday, November 05, 2019.
