

CITY OF CUPERTINO NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENTS TO THE CUPERTINO MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 5, ADOPTING NEW POLICIES REGULATING THE SALE OF TOBACCO

On Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at 6:45 p.m., the City Council of the City of Cupertino will conduct a public hearing to consider Municipal Code Amendments to the Cupertino Municipal Code, Title 5, adopting new policies regulating the sale of tobacco, such as requiring a local permit to sell tobacco products, prohibiting the sale of flavored tobacco, prohibiting new businesses from selling tobacco near schools and reducing tobacco retailer density, prohibiting tobacco sales at pharmacies and in vending machines, and limiting storefront signage. Location: citywide. Environmental Recommendation: Categorically Exempt. The project is categorically exempt as there is no potential for this action to cause a significant effect on the environment and/or any project would be exempt under relevant provisions of CEQA guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3).

If you wish to challenge the City Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall, 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014 at, or prior to the public hearing. Persons needing special assistance to attend the meeting under the Americans with Disabilities Act should call at least 48 hours prior to the public meetings to ensure their needs can be appropriately accommodated.

Please note that pursuant to Cupertino Municipal Code 2.08.100 written communications sent to the Cupertino City Council, Commissioners or City staff concerning a matter on the agenda are included as supplemental material to the agendized item. These written communications are accessible to the public through the City's website and kept in packet archives. Do not include any personal or private information in written communications to the City that you do not wish to make public; doing so shall constitute a waiver of any privacy rights you may have on the information provided to the City.
