

## CITY OF CUPERTINO NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CUPERTINO PARKS AND RECREATION SYSTEM MASTER PLAN AND ADOPTION OF A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

On Tuesday, February 18, 2020 at 6:45 p.m., the City Council of the City of Cupertino will conduct a public hearing to consider the Cupertino Parks and Recreation System Master Plan (Project) and adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project. The City of Cupertino is the lead agency and is presenting this Project for consideration. Project: The Cupertino Parks and Recreation System Master Plan (Project) is a planning document intended to ensure that the City parks and recreation system meets the needs of the Cupertino community, and to guide the City in allocating resources for future development, renovation, and management of City parks and recreation facilities through the year 2040. The key components of the Project include vision and goals, systemwide objectives and actions, opportunities for enhancements, and associated implementation actions. The Project is focused on City owned or managed developed parks and recreation facilities in Cupertino. Location: Citywide.

Environmental Review: The City prepared an Initial Study to evaluate the environmental impacts of the Project. The Initial Study concludes that with design features, best management practices and incorporation of mitigation measures, the Project would not have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore the City proposes to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration. All environmental documents for the Project are available for public review at the Cupertino City Hall lobby at 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA, and the Cupertino Library at 10800 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA. The documents are also available online in electronic format at the project website page at <a href="https://www.cupertino.org/parksmp">www.cupertino.org/parksmp</a>.

If you wish to challenge the City Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall, 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014 at, or prior to the public hearing. Persons needing special assistance to attend the meeting under the Americans with Disabilities Act should call at least 48 hours prior to the public meetings to ensure their needs can be appropriately accommodated.

Please note that pursuant to Cupertino Municipal Code 2.08.100 written communications sent to the Cupertino City Council, Commissioners or City staff concerning a matter on the agenda are included as supplemental material to the agendized item. These written communications are accessible to the public through the City's website and kept in packet archives. Do not include any personal or private information in written communications to the City that you do not wish to make public; doing so shall constitute a waiver of any privacy rights you may have on the information provided to the City.
