

Drive-thru COVID-19 testing at select Walgreens

Walgreens has partnered with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to open drive-thru testing locations in select areas. Testing is available at no-cost for people with and without health insurance coverage.

Who is eligible?

Individuals age 18 and older who meet the testing criteria established by the CDC are eligible*

How do I get tested?

- Go to the nearest testing location and follow the signs
- Bring a valid ID and insurance card if you have insurance coverage

How is the test administered?

- The test is a self-collection test using a nasal swab, while remaining inside your car
- Walgreens pharmacists will be on-site to provide instructions

How will I get results?

Tests are sent to independent, third-party labs for processing and results will be available in approximately 3 to 4 days. You will receive your results from Walgreens by phone or email, or you can get your results by registering on patient.labcorp.com
