

 - One special program or event*


*Eligible only to Cupertino Senior Center Members

Stay Active Fund (SAF)

- Anyone 50 years or older are eligible
- Ineligible to be used for trips, visitor passes, and flex passes.
- May only be used at the Senior Center

 - A third of clicks from virtual travel




July Newsletter Interactions
