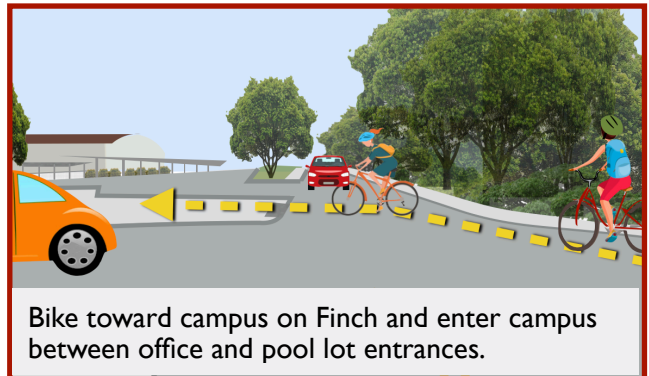

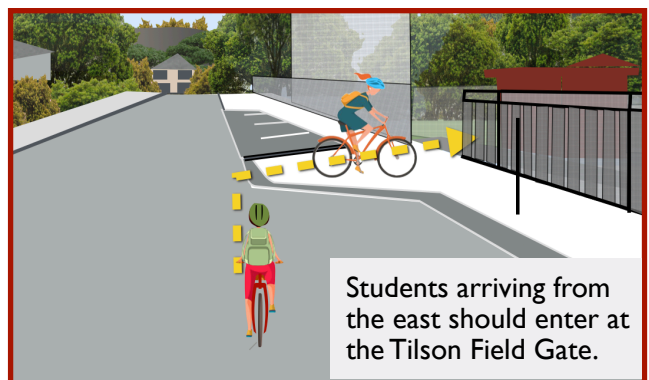
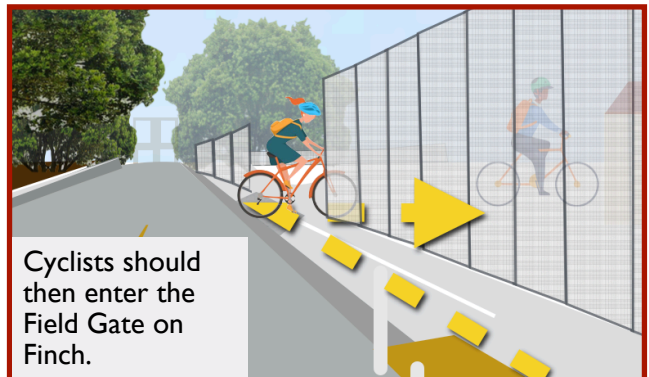
This is the best way to reduce traffic near Tino and make it safer for everyone.

Pay attention to your surroundings while walking or biking.



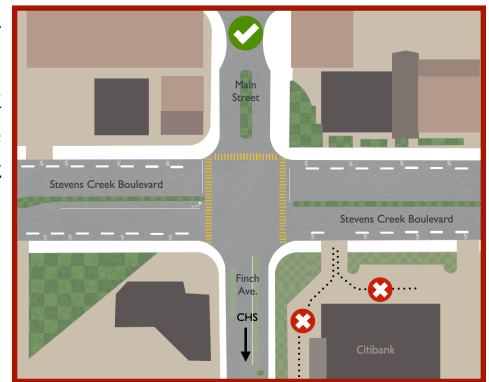
Look around

Don't wear earbuds while biking



Don't let your parents drop you off along Finch Avenue. Use the appropriate dropoff lane instead.

Don't let your parents drop you off at the Citibank parking lot. Use Main Street instead.



BE SAFE: HELPFUL TIPS

Cars do not stop on Finch at Calle de Barcelona. Bikes should yield when crossing at this intersection.



Do not pull out in front of cars when exiting campus at any location.



Use push-button flashers at Sorenson crosswalk and make eye contact with drivers at all crosswalks so they see you.
