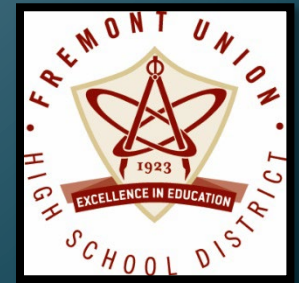

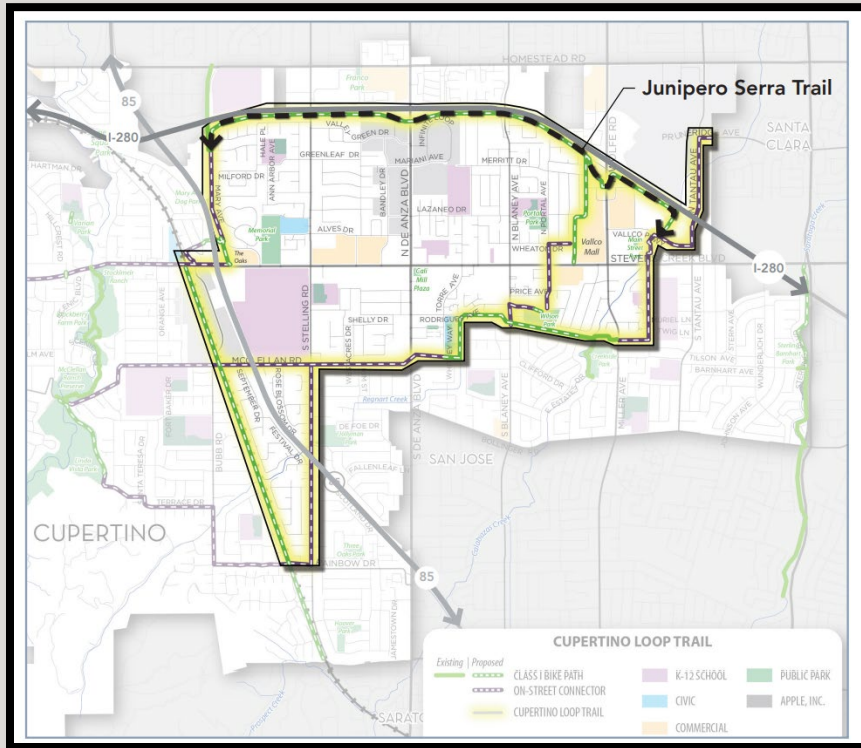

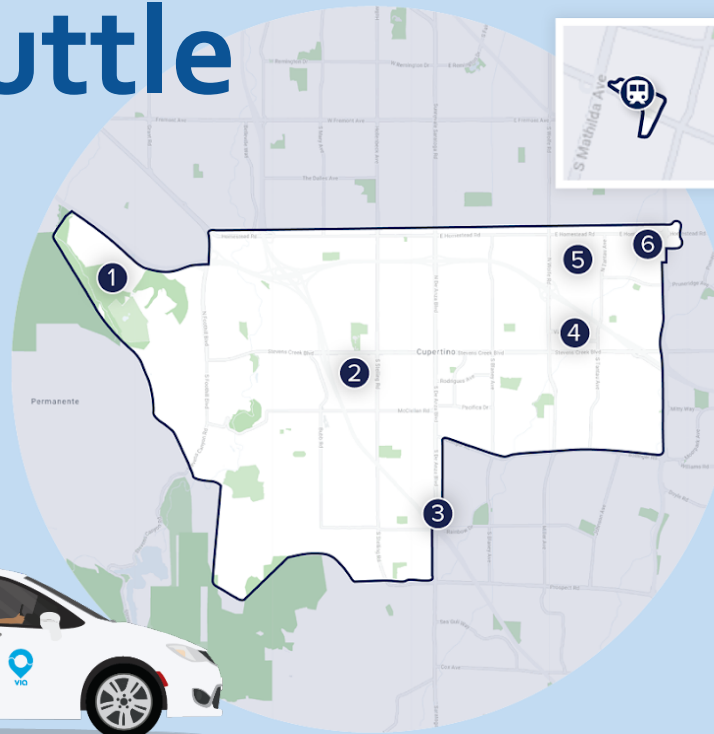

The basics.

Via works like a minibus that comes when you want, where you want. Book rides straight from your phone, get picked up steps from your front door, and commute or run errands without needing a car.

Service hours:

Monday-Friday 7am-7pm,
Saturday 9am-5pm.

Price:

Single ride: \$4 (seniors/low-income/
disabled/students ride for \$2).

Weekly pass: \$X (up to 4 rides per day).

4-week pass: \$Y (up to 4 rides per day).

LRSP will provide a framework for systematically identifying safety issues and making recommendations for roadway safety improvements in Cupertino.



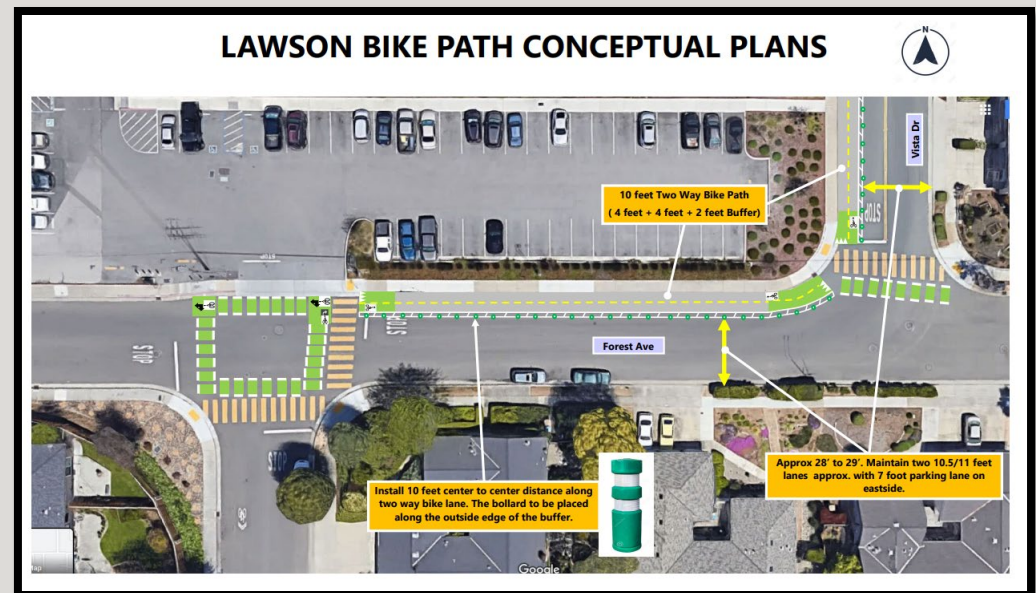
