NOTICE OF NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING**

The City of Cupertino is currently working with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) to position an ambient air monitoring station in Cupertino to measure our air quality. Monta Vista Park has been identified as a suitable location that will provide a representative picture of the broader community. The station is enclosed in an 11' x 24' trailer and will be accompanied by a 30' meteorological tower. The station will consume approximately three (3) parking spaces and be surrounded by a chain link fence. The tower will occupy a 4 x 4 cement pad located in a corner of the park. The air monitoring station will remain in Monta Vista Park for a minimum period of one (1) year. At the conclusion of monitoring, BAAQMD will remove the station and tower and restore the area to its present condition. The City of Cupertino is facilitating this neighborhood meeting in order for BAAQMD to present information on the technical specifications of the station and facilitate an open forum for resident questions. Please join us for a presentation by BAAQMD followed by an open session for your questions.
