

City of Cupertino Green Building Ordinance Process

The City of Cupertino is currently in the process of developing a Green Building Ordinance that:

- Aims to promote green practices (e.g., water, energy and resource conservation)
- Through the design, construction and maintenance of new buildings and existing buildings undergoing major renovations
- Including homes and commercial & industrial facilities



City of Cupertino Green Building Ordinance Process

- May 2010 City began seeking interested parties to participate in Green Building Focus Groups to help the City through the process of developing a Draft Green Building Ordinance.
- June 7th City held its first kick-off Focus Group meeting at the Kirsch Center. Over 65 participants attended.
- July 13th Planning Commission held a green building educational workshop.
- July 29th Second & Final Focus Group meetings were held in Community Hall. Key components of a Draft Green Building Ordinance were discussed.



City of Cupertino Green Building Ordinance Process

- City staff and Global Green, our green building consultant, are currently reviewing comments & suggestions from the July 29th focus group meetings to help develop a Draft Green Building Ordinance to present to the Planning Commission and City Council.
- Tentative public hearing dates include:
 - September 14 or 28 for Planning Commission
 - October 19 or November 2 for City Council
