SCHEDULE

The Spring semester will begin **February 6, 2012*** and conclude the week of **May 14, 2012***

TRANSPORTATION

It is the responsibility of the parent. Please drop off and pick up your children on time. On site supervision before and after class is **not** provided. Late pick ups may result in dismissal from the class without a refund. Students who attend late classes are requested to not wait at the school. Please leave school and return when the classes begin.

ELIGIBILITY

This program is available for kindergarten through eighth grade students living within the Cupertino Union School District boundaries.

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR

The teacher will establish rules for classroom behavior that **ALL STUDENTS** will be expected to follow at all times. A student who constantly misbehaves and hinders with the running of the class will be asked to leave the class and **NO REFUND** will be given.

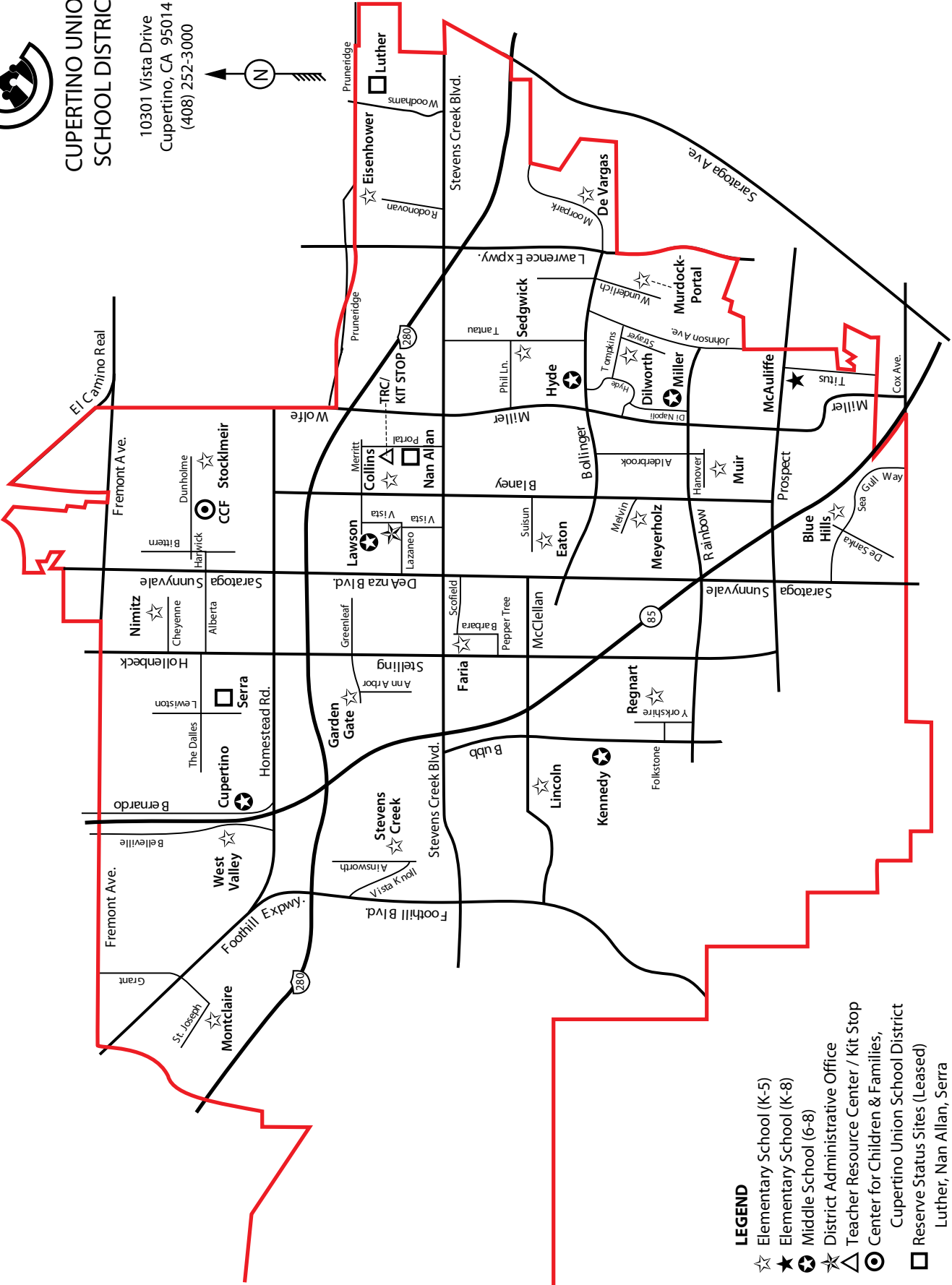
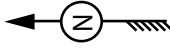
