RULES & PROCEDURES

Please abide by the following:

- 1. Follow directions from attendant regarding parking.
- 2. Do NOT block the Sunnyvale Rod & Gun Club entrance.
- 2. Bring:
 - a) Your driver's license or valid CA ID to verify Cupertino residency
 - b) Heavy duty plastic bags or garbage cans
 - c) Shovels
 - d) A helper (There are no staff to help you at the compost site)
 - e) A tarp & tie-downs to cover the load in your truck bed or protect your trunk
- 3. Residents are limited to 15 minutes of shoveling if other cars are waiting
