NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors has scheduled a public hearing at the meeting indicated below to consider the following application.

Tuesday, June 26, 2012, no earlier than 9:00 a.m.

Hearing to consider appeal of decision by the Planning Commission granting approval of Permanente Quarry Reclamation Plan Amendment and certification of the Environmental Impact Report on property located at 24001 Stevens Creek Boulevard. Property of Hanson Permanente Cement, Inc., mine operator is Lehigh Southwest Cement Company. (File No. 2250-10P APL – 10EIR APL) (Supervisorial District 5). The Reclamation Plan Amendment would amend the existing 1985 Permanente Quarry Reclamation Plan to reclaim all mined areas on the property, to comply with Surface Mine and Reclamation Act and County regulations. Lehigh is appealing the Planning Commission decision, made on June 7, 2012.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS MAY APPEAR AND BE HEARD during the public hearing in regard to the above-referenced consideration in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 70 West Hedding Street, First Floor, San Jose. Written communications should be filed with the Clerk of the Board prior to, the hearing date.
