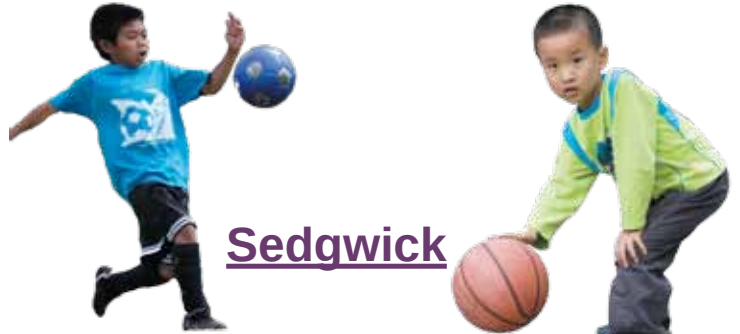

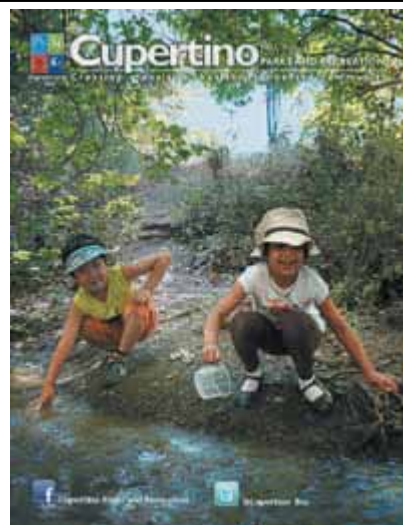

Map of School Sites



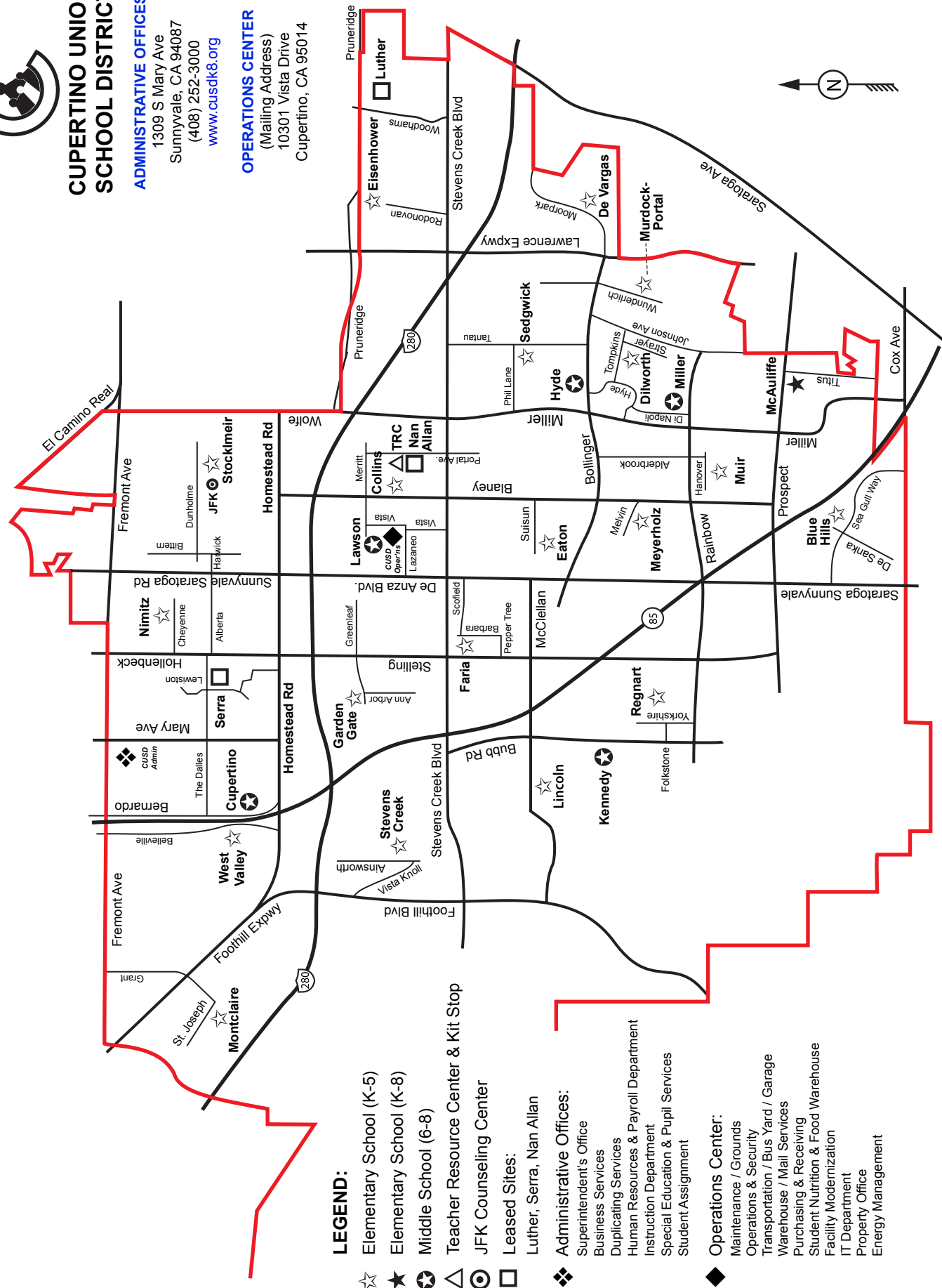
