

Cruising the Bay on the U.S.S. Potomac



The USS Potomac is a 165 foot vessel that was commissioned as a U.S. Navy vessel in 1936. It was used by President Franklin D. Roosevelt and named his "Floating White House". President Roosevelt used the ship for many of his secret meetings and getaways. The Potomac served as his yacht until his death in 1945.

After 1945, the Potomac began to decline from her former role in world

affairs. The ship went through various owners and even was once owned by Elvis Presley. In 1980, the ship was seized in San Francisco as a front for drug smugglers.

The ship was impounded at Treasure Island. A week before it was sold as scrap, the ship was rescued by the Port of Oakland and the restoration began, into the restored impressive ship it is today.
