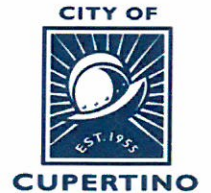

Day 1 / Oct. 30 / Miami

Day 4 / Nov. 2 / Grand Cayman

Grand Cayman boasts endless beaches that are encircled by coral reefs teeming with an abundance of marine life. On shore, affluent colonial neighborhoods dominate the West Bay area, while the East End affords natural attractions such as spectacular blowholes and botanical gardens.

Day 5 / Nov. 3 / AT SEA**Day 6 / Nov. 4 / Panama Canal/Panama City (Overnight)**

Spend an unforgettable day cruising the Panama Canal, a fifty-one-mile waterway through the rainforest that is one of the world's engineering masterpieces. The ship glides down the canal with inches to spare, through locks that raise and lower it like a toy.

Day 7 / Nov. 5 / Panama City

Panama City, Panama's capital city, is also the country's largest with a sea of skyscrapers on the scale of Manhattan. But Panama City is highly varied, including the original 16th-century settlement of Panama la Vieja, the Spanish-colonial capital of Casco Viejo, the modern business district of El Cangrejo and the Latin downtown area of La Expositcion.

Days 8 / Nov. 6 / AT SEA**Day 9 / Nov. 7 / Puerto Caldera**

The city of Puerto Caldera, on Costa Rica's Pacific Coast, has a number of national parks within easy reach for cruise visitors. Just to the south, Carara is a mecca for birders, especially those chasing the scarlet macaw. Poas Volcano is inland, and rises to nearly 9,000 feet. Barra Honda contains a series of limestone caves. Palo Verde preserves one of the last tropical dry rainforests in Central America. Arenal has the most active volcano in the country. Tapanti contains species of orchids that were not discovered until 2009.

Day 10 / Nov. 8 / Puerto Corinto

Puerto Corinto is a small town on the northwest coast of Nicaragua – a region bounded by great lakes to the south, Honduras to the north, and a concatenation of volcanic peaks to the east. The peaks demarcate an area of pristine beaches, fields of sugar cane, and lush mangrove forests. In Corinto, cruise visitors can stroll along the Costa Azul for a view of the bay and its islands. In nearby Chinandega, discover Mayan artifacts at the archeological museum. Farther afield explore the ruins of León Viejo, excavated from centuries of volcanic debris.

Day 11 / Nov. 9 / Puerto Quetzal

Once the center of the impressive ancient Mayan civilization, Guatemala was conquered by Spanish conquistador Pedro de Alvarado in 1524. During the second half of the 20th century, it experienced a variety of military and civilian governments as well as a 36-year guerrilla war. These issues have now faded into the past and today Guatemala is a thriving democracy with many varying landscapes, activities and historical venues waiting to be discovered.

Day 12-13 / Nov. 10-11 / AT SEA**Day 14-15 / Nov. 12-13 / Cabo San Lucas (Overnight)**

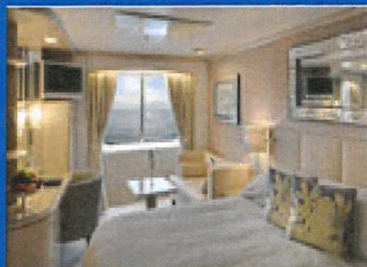
Cabo San Lucas is nestled on the southernmost tip of the Baja Peninsula, where the cool currents of the Pacific Ocean meet the warm waters of the Sea of Cortez. Commanding rock formations, timeless desert and a translucent sea provide a compelling introduction to this tranquil resort town. Here, mile upon mile of golden sandy coves dot the shoreline while marlin and sailfish frolic in the waters offshore.

Days 16/Nov. 14 / AT SEA**Day 17-18 / Nov. 15-16 / San Diego (Overnight)**

San Diego combines history with progress. Bordered on one side by the graceful Pacific Ocean lapping its shores and the hot desert plains on the other, this magical city is a festive and colorful attraction for tourists and locals. A short flight back to San Francisco ends a most memorable Crystal Panama Canal cruise.

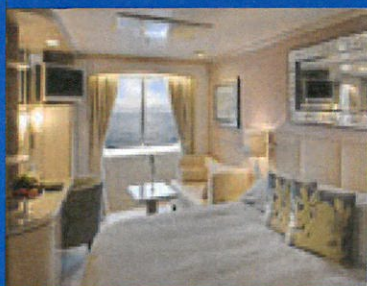
